

Travel directions to the Church of St John the Evangelist Vicarage Road, New Hinksey, Oxford, OX1 4RE

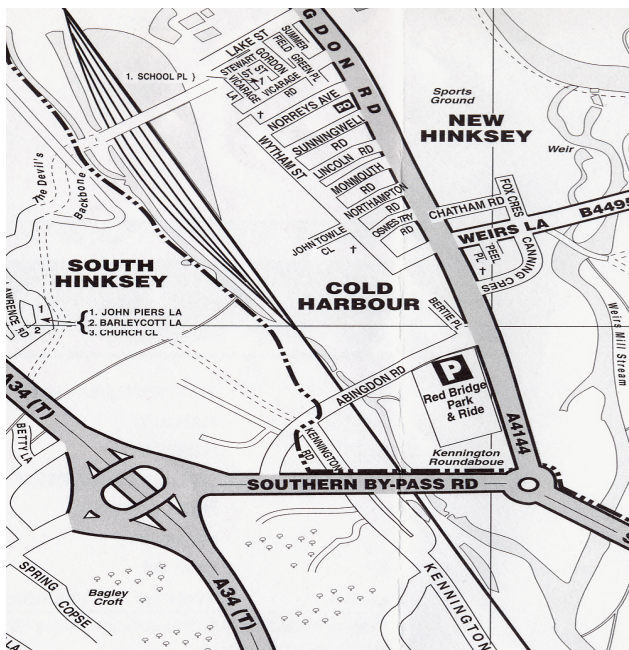
By Car and parking:

St John's is situated in New Hinksey, in the south of the city of Oxford within the ring road. From the Kennington roundabout on the ring road take the A4144 this leads to the Abingdon Road.

1. Redbridge Park and Ride. Either get the bus to the Lake Street stop on the Abingdon Road and walk down Vicarage Road or walk down Bertie Place and cut through the children's play area into Wytham Street. This is a 15 minute walk for those who are fit(ish). The church can be accessed through a foot gate at the end of Wytham Street.

2. Park in Wytham Street, Norrey Avenue, Sunningwell Road, Lincoln Road, Monmouth Road, Northampton Road or Oswestry Road. They all have unrestricted parking. The church can be accessed through a foot gate at the end of Wytham Street.

Disabled parking is available at the Church at the bottom of Vicarage Road.



After going over the second set of traffic lights after the Park and ride Vicarage Road is the 7th turning on the left. The Crooked Pot pub is at the junction of Abingdon Road and Vicarage Road.

The Church is at the very end of the road (as far as you can go) behind 2 wooden gates. Come through the gates and park on the gravel where you can. Please only park here if you need too, and **don't turn up without adequate time to park.**

By Train:

Walking via Oxpens Rd, Thames St and Abingdon Rd is just over a mile.

By Bus:
